MIP Background and Timeline

- <u>D.21-01-018</u> approved \$200 million statewide for MIP
 - 10 microgrid projects per electric IOU territory
 - \$15m per project cap
 - Single customer projects are excluded
 - "This program is intended for projects that are more complex with longer islanding duration for multiple customers as well as being targeted toward addressing the needs of vulnerable communities."
- Program Design and Implementation details not yet developed or approved
 - Stakeholder workshop needed first per <u>AL 6098-E-A</u>
 - Joint IOU Implementation Plan due October 4th, 2021
 - Project commercial operational deadline within 24 months of CPUC adoption of Implementation Plan
