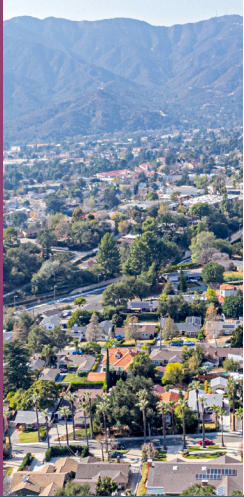

La Cañada USD - HS Gym

When a pipe break left La Cañada High School's gymnasium without hot water, the District turned to SoCalREN for support. Rather than reconnecting the central boiler, the District installed a new heat pump water heater—with 57% of the cost covered by SoCalREN. The result: reliable hot water for the gymnasium at half the cost, plus a more efficient system that sets the stage for long-term greenhouse gas reductions.

Maywood - Police Department

The City of Maywood partnered with SoCalREN to identify opportunities for energy-efficient water heater upgrades across its facilities. The first project focused on the Sheriff's Office, where a 30-gallon natural gas storage unit was replaced with a modern tankless model—fully funded by SoCalREN incentives. Building on this success, the City has three additional water heaters scheduled for replacements, ensuring reliable hot water and long-term energy savings at no cost to the City.

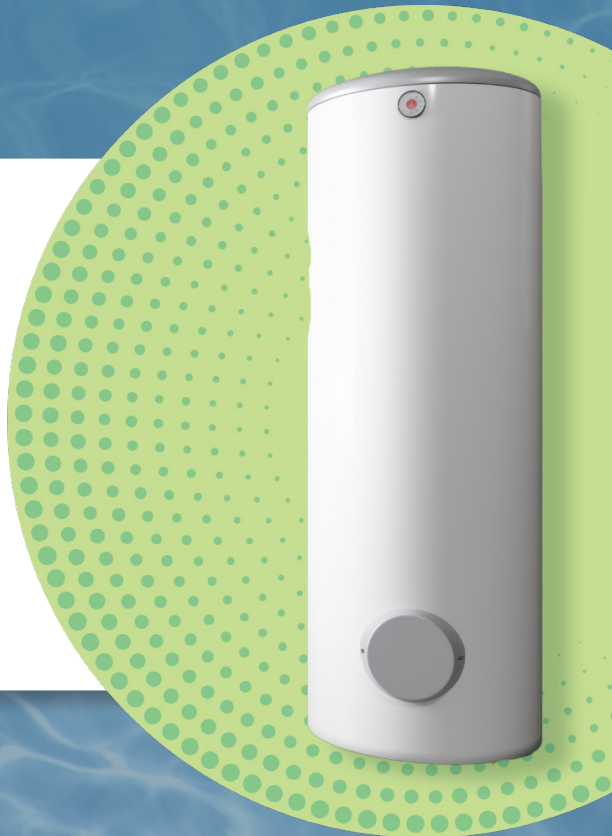
