

Contractor Performance Incentive: Race to 500,000 kWh!

Terms and Conditions

Project(s) must be installed and completed by an active SoCalREN Participating Contractor by December 31, 2021; 2020 projects or projects with 2022 completion dates are not eligible. One of each Performance Incentive is available, and one contractor company can win both Incentives. Participating contractors are automatically entered in the contest by submitting projects through the Trade Ally Portal. Project Completion is defined as when project enters the Final Application Review status in the Trade Ally Portal. Winners will be selected based on Project Completion timestamp from the Program's Trade Ally Portal. In the event of a tie, the project with the highest therms savings will be the winner.
